

June 16, 2026 – The status that is scheduled for June 26, 2026 was for the purpose of the parties reporting on discovery efforts, not for a hearing on discovery disputes. The issues between Ms. Read and the MSP arise from a subpoena served nearly a year ago, and the focus is on 473 emails for which notice was provided in February 2026 would be withheld. I am not willing to delay consideration of the issues for another 9 days, especially with the established discovery deadline. The motion is allowed to the extent that the scheduled hearing on the motion to compel against the MSP is taken off the list. I will decide the motion without a hearing. If Ms. Read and the MSP come to some resolution before I decide the motion, they shall notify Clerk Donovan by email to PlymouthSuperiorCtFilings@jud.state.ma.us. The hearings on the other motions to compel shall go forward as scheduled.

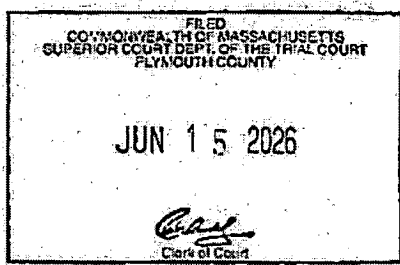

**ASSENTED-TO MOTION TO RESCHEDULE HEARING ON KAREN READ'S
MOTION TO COMPEL THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE POLICE TO PRODUCE
